Harvest of Hope (HOH) at the Dublin Food Pantry

A signature event supporting the clients is the Harvest of Hope Thanksgiving food drive. It is no longer a one-day pick-up, but rather they will be adding an extra box of Thanksgiving food to a client's monthly visit throughout the month of November. St. Patrick's has participated in this event since its very beginning. This year we have been asked to provide **Jiffy Cornbread** and **Canned Cranberry Sauce**, 400 of each. We ask that you drop off these items at the Dublin Food Pantry. As you enter the pantry from the parking lot behind the church there will be a box marked "HOH" on the right side of the hallway where the pantry food is dropped off. You should first weigh the food on the hallway scale and record it in the log book. Then put it in the designated HOH box. The pantry will keep a running tally to let us know when we have reached our goal. Or... drop donations in the red wagon at the doors to the narthex. The deadline for drop off is Oct. 17th.
